Registration Form Instructions

- 1) Application for registration must be initiated by the present owner.
- 2) Fill out application in its entirety. Incomplete applications may result in significant delays.
- 3) Include appropriate fee in U.S. funds in the form of check or money order (see fee schedule at right).
- 4) Use the Alpaca Color Chart number to identify the Paco-Vicuña color. Record the color name on front of this application. (Natural White #100, Beige #201, Golden #202, Vicuña #205, Dark Vicuña #301, and Mahogany #410).
- 5) If animal is registered in another registry, please provide a copy of certificate.

Naming Rules

- 1) Name can be no more than 35 characters including spaces and punctuation marks.
- 2) Name must begin with a letter.
- 3) Names must differ by at least one letter from all other names in the Registry.
- 4) Names must not use the business names or identifiers of other breeders and owners.
- 5) Names should not refer to any other business name or identifier (Vicuña, Paco-Vicuña, Alpaca, Llama, Guanaco or otherwise) other than that of the breeders/owners own business name.

DNA Testing

- 1) All registered Paco-Vicuñas must be DNA tested. The Registry uses DNA taken from roots of hair samples. These are sent to UC Davis Genetic Lab @ \$40/sample - see fees above.
- 2) Hair sample method: Take 4 plucks of 10-15 hairs each next to the skin. Hair should be the coarsest fiber from under side base of tail. Pinch hairs and jerk out hairs with roots.
- 3) Place all 4 plucks in same zip-lock plastic bag or envelope. Label with animal name and farm name.
- 4) Mail to Registry with this registration form.

Microchip

The Paco-Vicuña Registry™ requires permanent identification by microchip (usually implanted at the base of the left ear) due to physical similarities of many Paco-Vicuñas.

Histogram

A histogram is essential to attest to the animal's fiber quality. A copy should be sent in after each shearing.

Phenotype Category

Please use the registry's phenotype categories for your Paco-Vicuña or leave space blank and Registry will determine. The chart and explanation can be found on the web site at www.paco-vicunaregistry.com (contact the registry if you need a copy).
